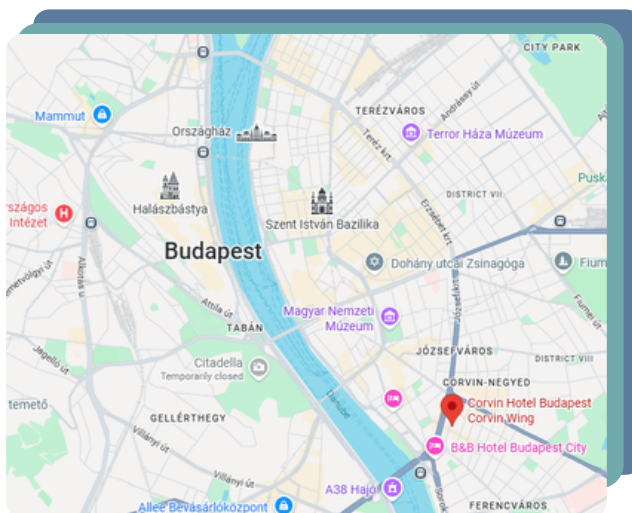

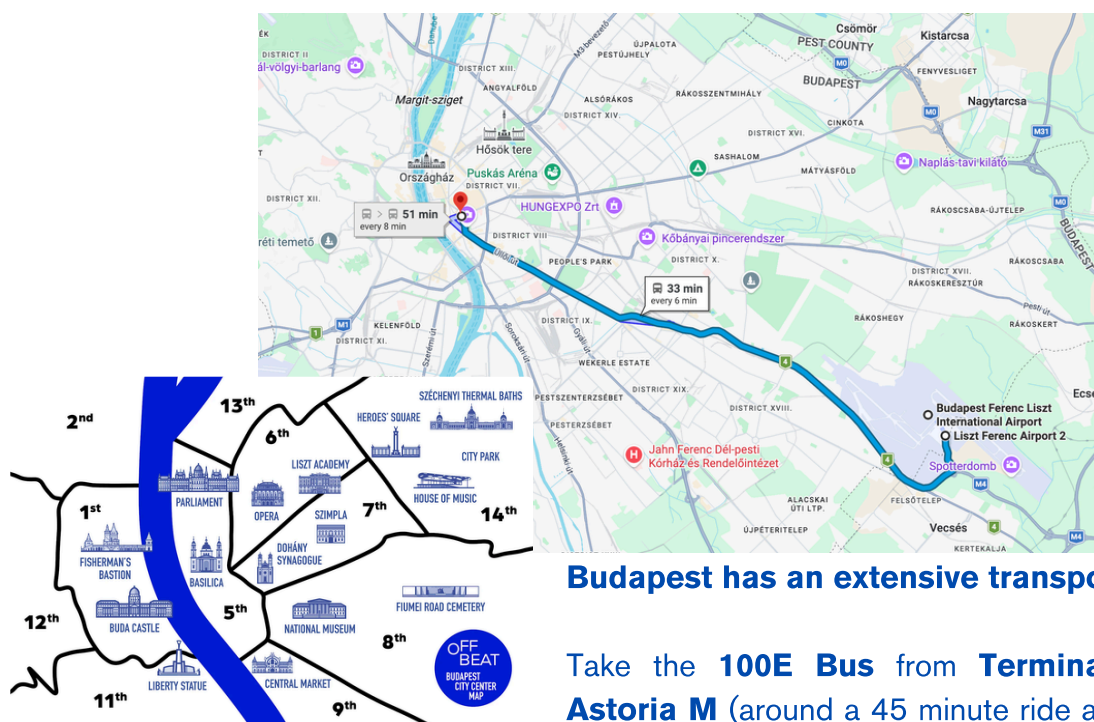

Budapest has an extensive transport map!

Take the **100E Bus** from **Terminal 2** until **Astoria M** (around a 45 minute ride and costs **7 euros**). From there, the entire city center can be reached by foot!

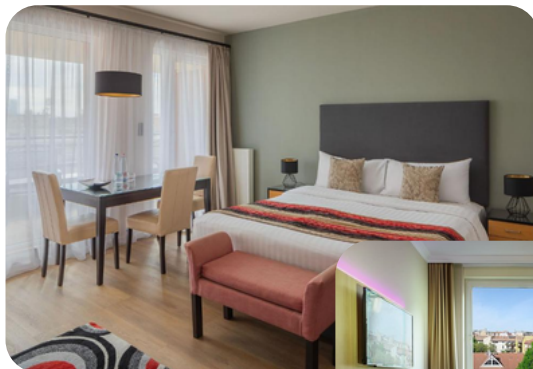


Hotel Options

If you can't stay at Corvin, here are some nearby options:

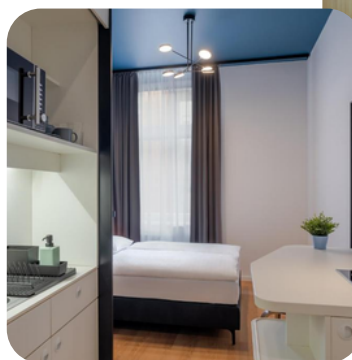
Escala Hotel & Suites
